For the second consecutive year, and thanks to the agreement with LARC, the international day of LGPL became the setting for FEGENTRI Maiden Cup, an international tournament of amateur lady riders which in 2016 had been run at Gavea racetrack and in this occasion was run on the turf track of Valparaíso Sporting Club.

Eight were the lady rider contestants, members of the European Federation presided by Nathalie Belinguier. The race, reserved for 3 year old fillies and run over 1 kilometer, was won by LA MAS CHIQUITA (CHI), ridden by Belgian rider Sarah Vermeersch.

The champion is property of Stud Gamboa and trained by Juan García V.
