OSAF PATTERN RACE COMMITTE MEETING IN LIMA, PERU

On Friday 18th of August during afternoon hours, the 5th meeting of OSAF Pattern Race Committee took place, at the premises of Jockey Club del Peru. The meeting counted with the participation of the independent Chairman of the Committee Mr Ciaran Kennelly, OSAF Chairman Mr Carlo Rossi, the Chairman of OSAF Technical Advisory in Ratings, medication and horse welfare affairs Mr Sergio Coutinho Nogueira, OSAF CEO Mr Oscar Bertoletti, and the representatives of countries which make up the Committee: From Argentina Dr. Ignacio Pavlovsky Jr and Mrs. Gabriela Alonso, from Brazil Ms Mayra Frederico, from Chile Mr. Italo Traverso, Jorge Farfán and Julián Bernal, from Peru Mr. Octavio Pedraza and José Meza and from Uruguay Mr. Luis Costa Baleta and Diego Montaño.

In the occasion of this meeting, each of the local committees put forward their individual average ratings corresponding to their pattern race calendar for the season between July 1st 2016 and June 30th 2017, and paying special attention to the evolution of the average of those races having received warning letters in 2016 for being at risk for not having met the required standards in the previous evaluation period.

Committees from Argentina, Brazil, Chile, Peru and Uruguay, all submited before OSAF a series of races for upgrades and downgrades, some of which were approved and others remaining pending for future Committee meetings, always in line with the criteria established by IFHA.

The summary of upgrades and downgrades proposed by this Committee, which will be put forward before IRPAC in their upcoming meeting in late September for final approval (or not), is as follows:

3. WARNING LETTERS: \bigstar



Given that some of the analyzed races do not meet the required Tolerance Level for their current category as by their 2 most recent years average and would be in risk of downgrading if they do not improve their averages in the next edition, OSAF Pattern Race Committee has decided to send the relevant Warning Letters to the racetracks staging the following Group races:

- 2. Clausura (La Plata) G2

- 3. Antenor Lara Campos (Cidade Jardim) G3
- 4. Independencia (Cidade Jardim) G3
- 5. José Cerquinho Assumpção (Cidade Jardim) G3

CHILE:

1. Velocidad (Club Hípico de Santiago) G2

URUGUAY, Part 2

As regards the evaluation of the Uruguayan pattern race calendar, of the 53 pattern races in Part 2, some of those races which meet the Standard Level for their category clearly stand out for the soundness of their ratings. These 3 races will be put forward for promotion to Part 1:

- Gran Premio General Artigas (G2)
- Comparación (G2)
- Ministerio de Economía y Finanzas DGC (G3)

4. CONCLUSIONS after the 5th meeting of OSAF Pattern Committee

Since this Committee's first meeting in November 2013, this is the summary of the changes which have been approved within the boundaries of this Committee and of IRPAC (under the guidelines set by IFHA), therefore ratifying that the region is working in harmony with the global criteria established by the International Federation. The application of these criteria is part of South America's work towards the international harmonization of the horseracing activity.
