

LONGINES GRAN PREMIO LATINOAMERICANO 2022

RESULTS



On Saturday 2nd of April at 18:30, on the dirt track of Hipódromo Chile, the running of the Grand Prix which features the best South American Thoroughbreds took place.

O'CONNOR (CHI) was the winner of this edition of Longines Gran Premio Latinoamericano (G1). The 4-year old Chilean bred, son of BOBOMAN and TORRENTE DEL AGUA, was led to victory by jockey Jorge González, winning by 7 3/4 lengths in a time of 2' 03'' 63c over 2000 meters. The winner, trained by Carlos Urbina, is property of Stud Irlandés and was born in Haras Carioca.

LONGINES CUP FERNANDO MOLLER BORDEU (G2) RESULTS

At 17:26 the Longines Cup Clásico Fernando Moller Bordeu was run over the mile at Hipódromo Chile. VIVIR CON ALEGRÍA (CHI) was the winner. The 3 year-old colt, son of FLYER and TRIN TRIN, was led to victory by jockey Jorge Zuñiga, winning by 1 3/4 lengths in a time of 1'35"32c. Owned and bred by Stud Haras Viejo Perro, the winner is trained by Alejandro Martínez.
