OSAF BOARD MEETING, DECEMBER 2025

On Friday, December 12th, the members of the OSAF Board convened for their final meeting of 2025. Chaired by Mr. Raúl Lima Neto (Jockey Club Brasileiro), the meeting was attended by representatives from the Argentine Jockey Club, Palermo Racecourse, Jockey Club de São Paulo, Club Hípico de Santiago, Hipódromo Chile, Valparaíso Sporting Club, Jockey Club del Peru, and HRU S.A., as well as the General Manager and Executive Secretary of the institution.

The main topics discussed were:

GRAN PREMIO LATINOAMERICANO 2026:

Hipódromo de Monterrico in Lima, Peru, was confirmed as the venue for the next Latino, to be held on Sunday, April 26th, 2026. The race will be for colts and fillies 3 years old and up, and will be run over 2,000 meters on turf track, with a maximum starter capacity of 16 competitors and a total purse of USD 300,000.

OSAF member racetracks confirmed that they will be nominating a total of 10 horses to compete in this edition of the Latino, leaving 6 starting gates available for extra-classified runners.

The schedule of milestones through April 2026 has been confirmed:

- Publication of the Latino Terms and Conditions booklet: January 15th 2026

Extra-Classified Runners:

- Deadline for application, extra-classified horses, including payment of pre-entry fee: February 20th
- Designation of extra-classified runners: March 20th 2026
- Deadline for payment of the entry fee balance (USD 24,000): March 20th 2026

Nominated Horses: Nomination of horses from member racetracks: March 16th 2026

FREIGHT: Flights for foreign runners will be 7 to 10 days prior to the event.

In addition to the Gran Premio Latinoamericano, the race meeting at Monterrico will feature another Group 1 race, the Clásico **PAMPLONA (G1)**, a **2000m race run on turf track, for fillies and mares 3 years old and up**. The purse for this race will be announced at the end of January and, is open to foreign runners.

FUTURE EDITIONS OF GRAN PREMIO LATINOAMERICANO

OSAF is working on establishing a schedule of venues for the next 4 editions of Gran Premio Latinoamericano, which will be announced during April 2026.



OSAF WORK PLAN 2026-2027

In order to strengthen the INTEGRITY of horseracing, which is based on 4 pillars - Sustainable Development, Jockey Welfare, Equine Welfare and Integrity Guarantees - and in line with IFHA guidelines, OSAF will work on the opportunities for improvement within the region, especially aimed at reinforcing the actions focused on Equine Welfare and Jockey Welfare, and those to promote horse racing integrity in all its aspects.

ATTENDANCE OF OSAF IN IFHA COMMITTEES IN HONG KONG IN DECEMBER:

An overview was given of the activities taking place during the first half of December in Hong Kong as part of the Longines Hong Kong International Races festival, where OSAF is participating through its representatives: International Movement of Horses Committee, International Conference of the Equine Welfare Research Foundation, International Handicappers Committee, International Conference for Jockey Health, Safety and Welfare, and IFHA Executive Committee.

OSAF TECHNICAL COMMITTEES MEETINGS DURING 2026:

The 2026 schedule for the technical committees was agreed, covering OSAF Board meetings; Handicappers; Racing Analysts, Veterinarians, and Equine Welfare; Stud Books; and the Pattern Race Committee.

Likewise, it was confirmed that during 2026, OSAF will continue carrying out the series of Webinars led by the International Ratings consultant Phil Smith, portraying the process of performance assessment and building of ratings, which OSAF releases (subtitled in Spanish) on its official YouTube channel: <https://www.youtube.com/@osafofficial>
