RESULTS, 42nd GRAN PREMIO LATINOAMERICANO (G1), 2026

AT MONTERRICO RACECOURSE, LIMA

On Sunday, April 26th at 5:30 PM, on the turf track of Monterrico Racecourse, the 42nd edition of the traditional stakes that brings together the best South American Thoroughbreds took place, where TEAO (CHI) emerged victorious.



The winner was nominated by Valparaíso Sporting Club and is a son of YA PRIMO (CHI), who won the Latino back in 2019 in Santiago de Chile. He is owned by Stud El Tata and was bred by Haras Don Alberto, son of YA PRIMO (CHI) and TI RECORDERAI (CHI). He is trained by Julio Orellana and was ridden to victory by jockey Luis Torres, winning by 2 lengths in a time of **2:00.11** over a distance of 2000 meters.
