CHILE HAS ALREADY NOMINATED THEIR 3 REPRESENTATIVES TO COMPETE IN GP LATINOAMERICANO 2026

OSAF is pleased to announce that the 3 Chilean member racecourses - Club Hípico de Santiago, Hipódromo Chile and Valparaíso Sporting Club - have officially nominated their representatives to compete in the Gran Premio Latinoamericano (G1) to be staged on April 26th at the Hipódromo de Monterrico, Lima, Peru.

MEDJOOL (CHI) was nominated by Club Hípico de Santiago. The 5-year-old, son of CONSTITUTION (USA) out of MONEDITA DE ORO (USA), owned by Stud El Mirador and bred by Haras Don Alberto, won the GP Verano Arturo Cousiño (G2) run on February 27th in Santiago de Chile. MEDJOOL (CHI) is trained by Julio Orellana and will be ridden by jockey Joaquín Herrera Olivares.



Hipódromo Chile nominated **APOLO REY (CHI)**, a 3-year-old son of MENDELSSOHN (USA) and BELLONCE (CHI). Owned by Stud Super Nico and bred by Haras Don Alberto, he is trained by Luis Urbina and recently won the GP St. Leger (G1) last December with Jorge A. González in the saddle and competed again in the Derby (G1), where he finished third.



Valparaíso Sporting appointed **TEAO (CHI)** as its representative for this edition of the Latino. The 3-year-old colt is owned by Stud El Tata, was bred at Haras Don Alberto and is the son of YA PRIMO (CHI) and TI RICORDERAI (CHI). Trained by Julio Orellana, he won El Derby (G1) on February 1st, ridden by jockey Luis Torres.
