On Saturday, September 5th, the race meeting at the Veliefendi Racecourse in Istanbul featured the **OSAF Cup** race, a Handicap for 3-year-olds over a distance of 1400m on the turf track.



The filly LEVERO took the victory by defeating PRENS LAUTARO by a neck, ridden by jockey Ali Kaçmaz in a time of 1m23s51c. The winner is trained by Kadir Tekinalp and is owned by Yavuz Caymaz.



Mr. Horacio Espósito (OSAF Advisor on International Affairs and Vice Chairman of IFHA) attended the racing festival and took part in the price giving ceremony on behalf of OSAF, presenting the trophies to the winners.
