JOCKEY CLUB BRASILEIRO NOMINATED ITS REPRESENTATIVE FOR GP LATINOAMERICANO 2026

OSAF is pleased to announce that today we have received the official nomination of the representative of Jockey Club Brasileiro to compete in the Gran Premio Latinoamericano (G1) to be held on April 26 at the Monterrico Racetrack, Lima, Peru.



OLYMPIC OMAN (BRZ) was the first nominee from Brazil. The 4-year-old colt, son of CAMELOT KITTEN (USA) and OLYMPIC INDIA (BRZ), owned by Stud Sampaio and bred by Haras Regina, won the GP Luiz Fernando Cirne Lima (G3) yesterday, Sunday, March 8th at Gávea Racecourse in Rio de Janeiro. OLYMPIC OMAN (BRZ) is trained by Roberto Morgado Neto and will be ridden by jockey Wilkley Xavier.

OLYMPIC OMAN has a record of 5 wins in 11 starts.
